Drugs Policy

The trustees of Yarm Fellowship Hall recognise they have a duty to provide a safe environment for its employees and the general public.

Any individual under the influence of misused legal drugs, over the counter preparations or other illegal substances, is a potential danger to him/herself and other people.

It is therefore prohibited for any individual to be in the Yarm Fellowship Hall, whilst in possession of illegal drugs or found to be misusing any substance.

Any employee found to be selling or misusing any kind of drug in the grounds or building will be liable to disciplinary action and dismissal.

Any visitor or individual renting the facilities found to be, or suspected of, misusing any substance will be asked to leave and will not be allowed to use the facilities again.

The trustees of Yarm Fellowship Hall nominate, by way of a written contract, the organisers of any event, to supervise all entrances to the Fellowship Hall.

The organisers of all events will hold a record of all persons having purchased tickets for events held in Yarm Fellowship Hall.

The trust will ensure a minimum of one appropriately trained first-aid person will be present during any event where alcohol is sold.
